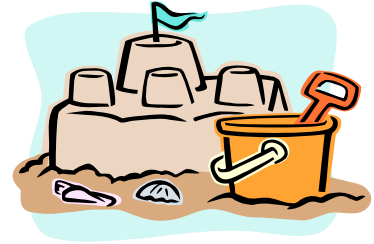




Trees-to-Sea Harborfest **Sand Sculpture Contest**

RULES

1. Each team is limited to a maximum of 6 persons.
2. Each team is limited to working within the 20 by 20 foot space you have been assigned. Your team must use sand only from within the sand plot assigned to your team.
3. Sculptures must have a nautical, marine life or harbor-related theme.
4. The only material that may be used to create your sculpture is sand from inside your assigned space and sea water from the ocean. No decorative material, no artificial coloring, no paints, no flour, sugar, cement, or adhesives may be added. Seashells, driftwood, seaweed or other marine life cannot be used in your sculpture.
5. Each team can start sand sculpting at 10 am and must finish by no later than 1:30 pm.
6. Only the following tools can be used to create your sculpture:
 - a. buckets for gathering seawater
 - b. hand tools for carving , shaping and moving sand,
 - c. Spray bottles filled with sea water for keeping your sculpture damp.
 - d. Flexible plastic sheets or a sheet of 30 weight roofing paper may be used as forms. No wooden forms allowed.
 - e. No powered tools or equipment allowed.
7. Event organizers reserve the right to halt sculpting at any assigned site for safety or any other reason.
8. First place prizes will be given to the first place team in each division. Award trophies will be given to First, Second and Third place teams in each division.
9. Entries will be judged based on creativity and quality of construction. Judges decisions are final.
